Remove lines 34-49 and insert:

Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 110.114, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

110.114 Employee wage deductions.-

Remove lines 121-184 and insert:

- 447.303 Dues; deduction and collection of dues or uniform assessments prohibited; exceptions.—
- (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a public employer may not deduct or collect the dues, uniform assessments, fines, penalties, or special assessments of an employee organization from the compensation of any person employed by the public employer.
- (2) Any employee organization which has been certified as a bargaining agent and that represents employees who are law

enforcement officers, as defined in s. 943.10(1), or firefighters, as defined in s. 633.30(1), shall have the right to have its dues and uniform assessments deducted and collected by the employer from the salaries of those employees who authorize the deduction of said dues and uniform assessments. However, such authorization is revocable at the employee's request upon 30 days' written notice to the employer and employee organization. Said deductions shall commence upon the bargaining agent's written request to the employer. Reasonable costs to the employer of said deductions shall be a proper subject of collective bargaining. Such right to deduction, unless revoked pursuant to s. 447.507, shall be in force for so long as the employee organization remains the certified bargaining agent for the employees in the unit. The public employer is expressly prohibited from any involvement in the collection of fines, penalties, or special assessments.
