55.03 Judgments; rate of interest, generally.-

9 (1) On December 1, March 1, June 1, and September 1 of each year, the Chief Financial Officer shall set the rate of 10 11 interest that shall be payable on judgments or decrees for the 12 calendar quarter year beginning January 1, April 1, July 1, and 13 October 1 by averaging the discount rate of the Federal Reserve 14 Bank of New York for the preceding 12 months year, then adding 400 500 basis points to the averaged federal discount rate. The 15 16 Chief Financial Officer shall inform the clerk of the courts and chief judge for each judicial circuit of the rate that has been 17 18 established for the upcoming quarter year. The interest rate 19 established by the Chief Financial Officer shall take effect on

The 12 prison diversion program shall be designed to meet the unique 13 needs of each judicial circuit and of the offender population of 14 that circuit. The program may require a term of imprisonment in 15 jail not to exceed 90 days; electronic monitoring; residential, 16 nonresidential, or day-reporting requirements; substance abuse 17 treatment; employment; restitution; academic or vocational 18 opportunities; or community service work.
