PROPOSED SPECIAL PROCEDURE FOR DEBATE ON THIRD READING OF CS/CS/HB 7005 ADOPTED BY THE RULES & CALENDAR COMMITTEE Monday, March 7, 2011

Dear Mr. Speaker,

The following report is submitted pursuant to Rule 10.12 for the purpose of establishing the procedures for debate on third reading of CS/CS/HB 7005.

Final debate on third reading of CS/CS/HB 7005 on the floor on Thursday, March 10, 2011 shall be limited to no more than the time specified below, with the time equally divided between the Majority and Minority parties. From this allotted time, the Speaker's floor manager will open and close each bill. The floor manager shall designate time to open and close, not to exceed 5 minutes each, and communicate that time to the Clerk. After opening the bill, the floor managers from the Majority and Minority parties shall be alternately recognized until their time runs out. Time not utilized is lost.

The Minority Leader and the Speaker may each designate one floor manager. The floor managers may speak in debate and yield time to other Members to debate. Recognitions of floor managers must go through the Speaker. A Member may not be recognized more than once in debate on the bill.

No Member may be recognized for debate unless a floor manager yields time to that Member.

There will be no other debate on CS/CS/HB 7005 on March 10, 2011.

The time limitations for the bill is as follows:
