#### Amendment (with title amendment)

Between lines 14 and 15, insert:

Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 465.025, Florida Statutes, is amended, and subsection(9) is added to that section; to read:

465.025 Substitution of drugs.-

- A pharmacist who receives a prescription for a brand name drug shall, unless requested otherwise by the purchaser, substitute a less expensive, generically equivalent drug product that is:
- Distributed by a business entity doing business, and subject to suit and service of legal process, in the United States; and

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(b) Listed in the formulary of generic and brand name drug products as provided in subsection (5) for the brand name drug prescribed,

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unless the prescriber writes the words "MEDICALLY NECESSARY," in her or his own handwriting, on the face of a written prescription; unless, in the case of an oral prescription, the prescriber expressly indicates to the pharmacist that the brand name drug prescribed is medically necessary; or unless, in the case of a prescription that is electronically generated and transmitted, the prescriber makes an overt act when transmitting the prescription to indicate that the brand name drug prescribed is medically necessary. When done in conjunction with the electronic transmission of the prescription, the prescriber's overt act indicates to the pharmacist that the brand name drug prescribed is medically necessary. Notwithstanding this subsection, a pharmacist may not substitute an opioid analgesic drug, brand or generic, for an opioid analgesic drug incorporating a tamper-resistance technology which was originally prescribed and is listed by the Board of Pharmacy under subsection (9).

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(9) The Board of Pharmacy shall establish by rule a list of opioid drugs which incorporate tamper-resistant technology.

Inclusion of a drug on the list does not require that the drug bear a labeling claim with respect to reduction of tampering, abuse, or abuse potential at the time of listing. The Board shall make a determination whether to include a drug on the list

based on a submission of evidence by the drug manufacturer or distributor that the drug:

- (a) Incorporates a tamper-resistance technology; and
- (b) Has been approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration pursuant to an application that includes at least one study on human tampering or abuse potential or a laboratory study comparing the tamper- or abuse-resistant properties of the drug to one or more opioid drugs that has been approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration and serves as a positive control.
