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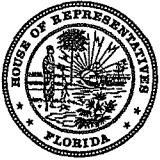

than \$3,400. If the individual is ineligible for benefits calculated on a base period wage, wages must be calculated using an alternative base period and the claimant must have the opportunity to choose whether to establish a claim using such wages. Wages can be calculated for an alternative base period only if the base period wages are inadequate to establish eligibility under this paragraph and only for benefit years that begin on or after January 1, 2011. Wages used to establish a monetarily eligible benefit year may not be used to establish monetary eligibility in a subsequent benefit year.

on page 11, line 286 insert

5. As used in this paragraph, the term "good cause" means:

a. Cause attributable to the employing unity or an illness or disability that requires separation from work;

b. Domestic violence, as defined in s. 741.28, and a verified by reasonable and confidential documentation that causes the individual to reasonably believe that continued employment will jeopardize the individual's safety and the safety of a member of his or her immediate family;

c. Illness or disability of a member of the individuals' immediate family; or

d. The individual's need to accompany her or his spouse if the spouse's relocation resulted from a change in the spouse's employment and the relocation makes it impractical for the individual to commute to her or his workplace.
