2009-10 Florida College System Employee Contract Information:

- In 2009-10, the College System had 51,662 employees, of which 19,318 were full-time
- Of the 19,318 full-time employees, 10,925 were contractual employees
- Of the 10,925 contractual employees, 5,403 were on or earning continuing contract:
 - o 3,962 of the 5,403 had a continuing contract
 - 1,441 of the 5,403 were on track to earn continuing contract
- Of the 10,925 contractual employees, 5,552 (50.54%) were on an annual contract
- Of the 10,925 contractual employees:
 - o 227 Executives of which 11 were on continuing contract and one on track to earn continuing contract
 - 5,709 total full-time instructional staff, of which 5,018, had or were on track to earn continuing contract
 - o 60 Instructional Support Staff (out of 495) had or were on track to earn continuing contract
 - o 216 Librarians and Counselors (out of 290) had or were on track to earn continuing contract
 - o 97 Professional Support Staff (out of 4,204) had or were on track to earn continuing contract
- The College System had 5,709 full-time and 21,585 part-time faculty
