The department shall estimate annually in advance the 23 amount necessary for the administration of this subsection and the maintenance of this fund pursuant to this paragraph and 24 shall make such assessment in the manner hereinafter provided. 25 26 By July 1 of each year, the department shall calculate the assessment rate, which shall be based upon the net premiums 27 28 written by carriers, the amount of premiums calculated by the department for self-insured employers, and the anticipated 29 30 balance and expenses of the Special Disability Trust Fund for the next calendar year. Such assessment rate shall take effect 31 January 1 of the next calendar year. 40 a. The sum of disbursements from the fund during the
