7 maintenance costs of the facility. A county levying the tax for
8 the purposes in this subparagraph may do so only by a majority
9 plus one vote of the membership of the board of county

11 revenues by majority votes of the electors voting in referendums
12 held in the county in which the facility is located and each
13 contiguous county within 10 miles of the facility. Referendum
14 approval of the proposed use of tax revenues may be in an
15 election held prior to or after the effective date of the law
16 enacting this subparagraph. The referendum ballot must include a
17 brief description of the proposed used of tax revenues and the
