Amendment to Amendment (827961) by Representative Smith

Remove lines 1367-1383 of the amendment and insert:

6 (12)(a) There is established the Congressman C. W. Bill
7 Young Veteran Tuition Waiver Program. A state university, a
8 Florida College System institution, a career center operated by
9 a school district under s. 1001.44, or a charter technical
10 career center shall waive out-of-state fees for an honorably
11 discharged veteran of the United States Armed Forces, the United
12 States Reserve Forces, or the National Guard who physically
13 resides in this state while enrolled in the institution. Tuition
14 and fees charged to a veteran who qualifies for the out-of-state
15 fee waiver under this subsection may not exceed the tuition and
16 fees charged to a resident student. The waiver is applicable for
17 110 percent of the required credit hours of the degree or

18 certificate program for which the student is enrolled. Each
19 state university, Florida College System institution, career
20 center operated by a school district under s. 1001.44, and
21 charter technical career center shall report to the Board of
22 Governors and the State Board of Education, respectively, the
23 number and value of all fee waivers granted annually under this
24 subsection.

25 (b) This subsection may be cited as the "Congressman C.W.
26 Bill Young Tuition Waiver Act."
