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(2) This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset 28 Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15, Florida Statutes, and 29 30 shall stand repealed on October 2, 2019, unless reviewed and 31 saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature. Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public 32 necessity that personal identifying information of a person who 33 34 is employed by or under contract with a public research 35 facility, including a state university, that conducts animal research or is engaged in activities related to animal research, 36 be made exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s. 37 38 24(a), Article I of the State Constitution. The Legislature 39 finds that the release of such personal identifying information 40 will place such persons in danger of threats and harassment as well as physical and emotional harm from those who advocate 41 42 against such research. University employees have been harassed 43 and threatened after animal care records that included their personal identifying information were disclosed pursuant to 44 public records requests. Thus, the Legislature finds that the 45 harm and threat to such persons' safety that results from the 46 47 release of personal identifying information in records about the animals or about the animal research outweighs any public 48 49 benefit that may be derived from the disclosure of the information. The public research facilities, including state 50 51 universities, remain responsible and accountable for the animal 52 research conducted at their institutions.

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Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014.

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
