401.252 Interfacility transfer.-

- (2) (a) A licensed basic or advanced life support service may conduct interfacility transfers in a permitted ambulance if the patient's treating physician certifies that the transfer is medically appropriate and the physician provides reasonable transfer orders. An interfacility transfer must be conducted in a permitted ambulance if the patient:
- 1. Is bed confined, as defined by the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services;
