48.062 Service on limited liability companies. --

- (1) Process against any limited liability company, domestic or foreign, may be served on the registered agent designated by the limited liability company under Chapter 608. A person attempting to serve process pursuant to this paragraph may serve the process on any employee of the registered agent during the first attempt at service even if the registered agent is a natural person and is temporarily absent from his or her office.
- (2) If service cannot be made on a registered agent of the limited liability company because of failure to comply with Chapter 608 or because the limited liability company does not have a registered agent, or if its registered agent cannot with

- (d) (b) "Handicapped Person who has a disability" means a any person who has a mental or educational impairment that which substantially limits one or more major life activities.
 - (b) (c) "Mental or educational impairment" means:
- 1. \underline{A} Any mental or psychological disorder or specific learning disability.

- (c) "Military service member" means a person who is on active duty in or a veteran of the United States Armed Forces.
 - 1. "Active duty" has the same meaning as in s. 250.01.
 - 2. "Veteran" has the same meaning as in s. 1.01.
- (2) A Any person who is willfully using, or has willfully used, a method, act, or practice in violation of this part, which method, act, or practice victimizes or attempts to victimize a senior citizen citizens or a person who has a disability handicapped persons, and commits such violation when she or he knew or should have known that her or his conduct was unfair or deceptive, is liable for a civil penalty of not more than \$15,000 for each such violation if she or he knew or should have known that her or his conduct was unfair or deceptive.

- 3. Any expense incurred by an association pursuant to this paragraph is chargeable to the unit owner and enforceable as an assessment pursuant to s. 718.116, and the association may use its lien authority provided by s. 718.116 to enforce collection of the expense.
- 4. The association may petition a court of competent jurisdiction for the appointment of a receiver and may rent an abandoned unit for the benefit of the association to offset the association's costs and expenses of maintaining, preserving, and protecting the unit and the appurtenant common elements, including the costs of the receivership and all unpaid assessments, interest, late fees, and attorney fees

- (c) The association may adopt reasonable written rules governing the frequency, time, location, notice, records to be inspected, and manner of inspections, but may not require a parcel owner to demonstrate any proper purpose for the inspection, state any reason for the inspection, or limit a parcel owner's right to inspect records to less than one 8-hour business day per month. The association may impose fees to cover the costs of providing copies of the official records, including, without limitation, the costs of copying. The association may charge up to 50 cents per page for copies made on the association's photocopier. If the association does not have a photocopy machine available where the records are kept, or if the records requested to be copied exceed 25 pages in length, the association may have copies made by an outside vendor or association management company personnel and may charge the actual cost of copying, including any reasonable costs involving personnel fees and charges at an hourly rate for vendor or employee time to cover administrative costs to the vendor or association. The association shall maintain an adequate number of copies of the recorded governing documents, to ensure their availability to members and prospective members. - 2. Information obtained by an association in connection with the approval of the lease, sale, or other transfer of a parcel.
- 3. Personnel records of the association's employees, including, but not limited to, disciplinary, payroll, health, and insurance records. For purposes of this subparagraph, the term "personnel records" does not include written employment agreements with an association employee or budgetary or financial records that indicate the compensation paid to an association employee.
- 4. Medical records of parcel owners or community residents.
- 5. Social security numbers, driver's license numbers, credit card numbers, electronic mailing addresses, telephone numbers, facsimile numbers, emergency contact information, any addresses for a parcel owner other than as provided for association notice requirements, and other personal identifying information of any person, excluding the person's name, parcel designation, mailing address, and property address.
