#### (12) ARREST BOOKING PHOTOGRAPHS

(a) A county or municipal detention facility may not electronically publish or disseminate an arrest booking photograph of any arrestee who is charged with but not yet convicted of a criminal offense. This paragraph does not apply to the electronic publication or dissemination of arrest booking photographs between criminal justice agencies.
