Section 3. Subsections (4) and (5) of section 961.06, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

961.06 Compensation for wrongful incarceration.-

amount determined by the department to an insurance company or other financial institution admitted and authorized to issue purchase an annuity contracts in this state to purchase an annuity or annuities, selected by the wrongfully incarcerated person, on behalf of the claimant for a term of not less than 10 years. The Chief Financial Officer is directed to execute all necessary agreements to implement this act and to maximize the

benefit to the wrongfully incarcerated person. The terms of the annuity or annuities shall:

- (a) Provide that the annuity <u>or annuities</u> may not be sold, discounted, or used as security for a loan or mortgage by the wrongfully incarcerated person applicant.
- (b) Contain beneficiary provisions for the continued disbursement of the annuity or annuities in the event of the death of the wrongfully incarcerated person applicant.
- compensation Chief Financial Officer draws the warrant for the purchase of the annuity, the wrongfully incarcerated person claimant must sign a release and waiver on behalf of the wrongfully incarcerated person claimant and his or her heirs, successors, and assigns, forever releasing the state or any agency, instrumentality, or any political subdivision thereof, or any other entity subject to the provisions of s. 768.28, from all present or future claims that the wrongfully incarcerated person claimant or his or her heirs, successors, or assigns may have against such entities arising out of the facts in connection with the wrongful conviction for which compensation is being sought under the act. The release and waiver must be provided to the department prior to the issuance of the warrant by the Chief Financial Officer.
