559.77 Civil remedies.-

(2) Any person who fails to comply with any provision of s. 559.72 is liable for actual damages and for additional statutory damages as the court may allow, but not exceeding \$1,000, together with court costs and reasonable attorney's fees <u>in accordance with s. 57.105</u> incurred by the plaintiff. In determining the defendant's liability for any additional statutory damages, the court shall consider the nature of the

18 defendant's noncompliance with s. 559.72, the frequency and persistence of the noncompliance, and the extent to which the 19 20 noncompliance was intentional. In a class action lawsuit brought under this section, the court may award additional statutory 21 damages of up to \$1,000 for each named plaintiff and an 22 23 aggregate award of additional statutory damages up to the lesser of \$500,000 or 1 percent of the defendant's net worth for all 24 remaining class members; however, the aggregate award may not 25 provide an individual class member with additional statutory 26 damages in excess of \$1,000. The court may award punitive 27 damages and may provide such equitable relief as it deems 28 29 necessary or proper, including enjoining the defendant from further violations of this part. If the court finds that the 30 31 suit fails to raise a justiciable issue of law or fact, the plaintiff is liable for court costs and reasonable attorney's 32 33 fees in accordance with s. 57.105 incurred by the defendant.
