

Since our last information sheet was written, we have had several changes to our Engraved Brick Order Form, and other important events have occurred which will be of interest to all Florida Veterans and Veteran Families. The first important event occurred on 12 November, 2014 when Governor Scott emplaced the 1st memorialized engraved brick in the Florida Veterans Walk of Honor with appropriate ceremony. The first brick was in honor of Lance Corporal Daniel B. Chaires, USMC, who gallantly gave his life for his country on 10/25/2006 in Iraq. Three other engraved bricks were also placed in the Florida Veterans Walk of Honor on that day.

Another important change in the prices of engraved bricks has occurred and is as follows:

- \$200.00 each for engraved bricks placed in the Medal of Honor Center Node. Only 1,548 of these bricks can be sold.
- 2. \$150.00 for the Florida Veterans Walk of Honor. Approximately 23,480 brick can be sold in this area at this price.
- 3. \$125.00 for the Florida Veterans Court of Honor bricks. 175,000 total bricks can be sold at this price for this area.

Our plans call for the Walk of Honor to be built in phases, with the first phase being the Medal of Honor Center node. When the Medal of Honor Center Node is completed, we will schedule an appropriate ceremony, with an invitation to everyone who has ordered a brick for the center node, plus we will invite the families of our Florida Veterans whose names are emplaced in the MOH center node. We will also invite the Governor and his cabinet, and all members of the Florida Legislature.

Please remember that mini bricks are available to everyone who orders the larger 4"x8" bricks. The sales price for the mini bricks are \$25.00 each with no limitation on the number of mini bricks that can be ordered with the 4"x8" honor brick.

Please remember that the Florida Veterans Foundation is a 501(c)(3), tax exempt organization. All proceeds from the sale of engraved bricks will be used to pay for the construction of the Florida Veterans Memorial, Walk of Honor and the Veterans court of Honor with the remainder of the funds going to the Florida Veterans Foundation to assist in the primary mission of providing emergency financial assistance to veterans and their families who are experiencing financial difficulties which can develop into a catastrophic situation if not resolved.
