Assembly Bill 2293 (Bonilla) - SUPPORT

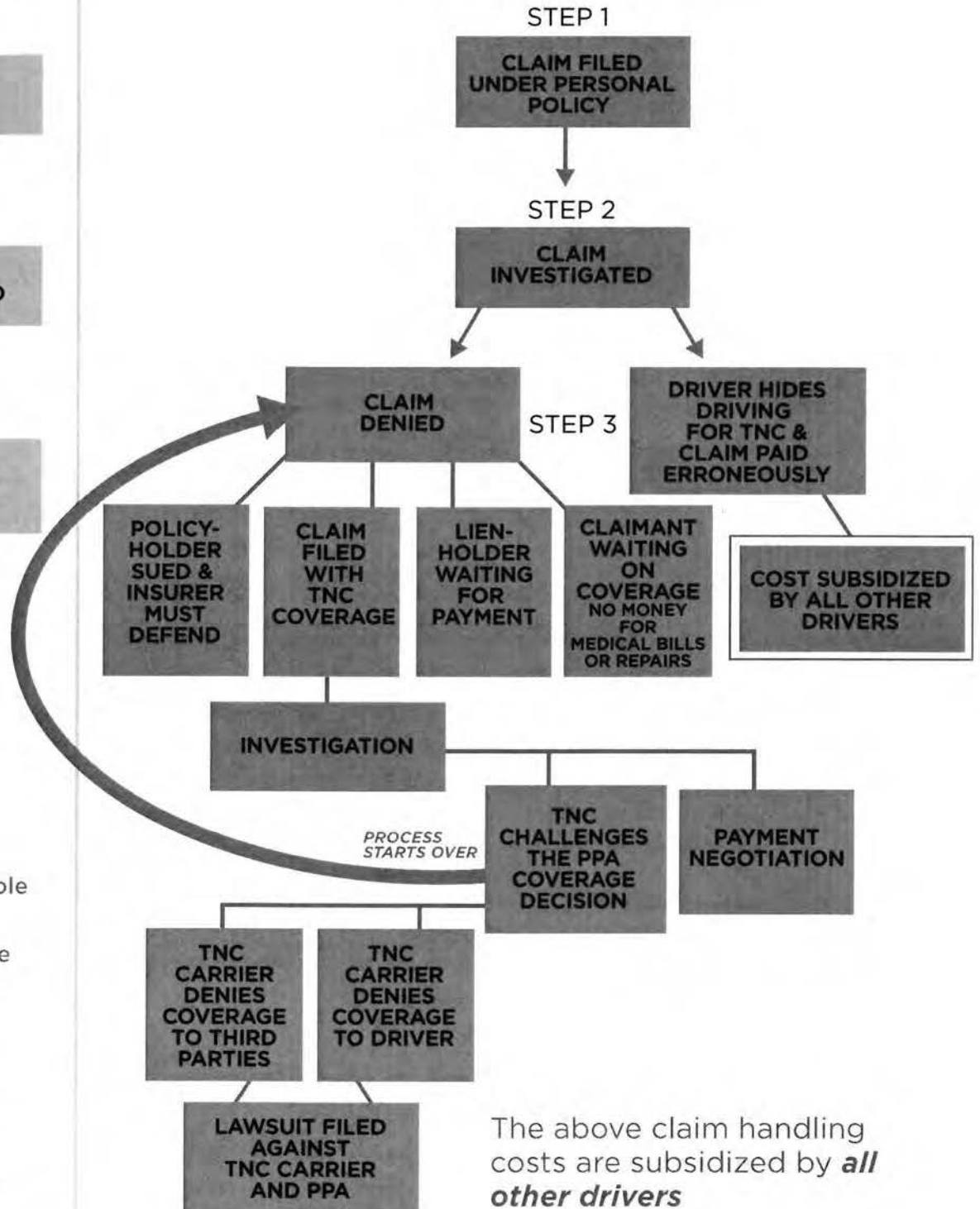
