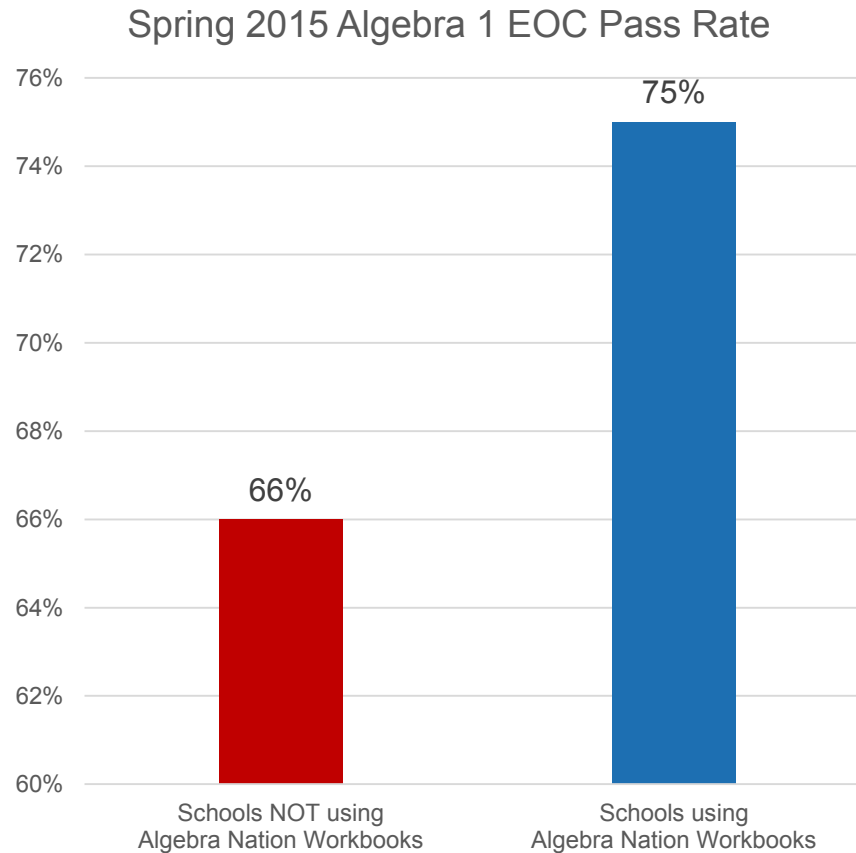

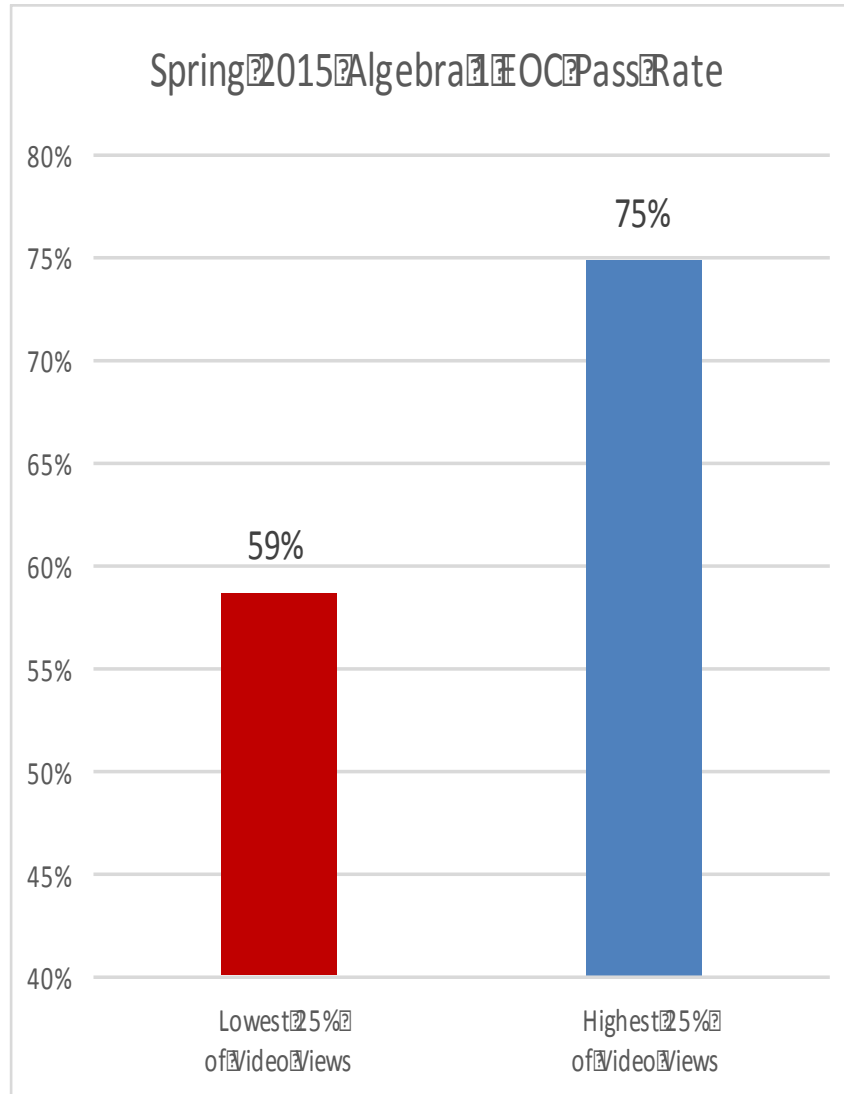

Algebra Nation Impact on EOC Test Scores

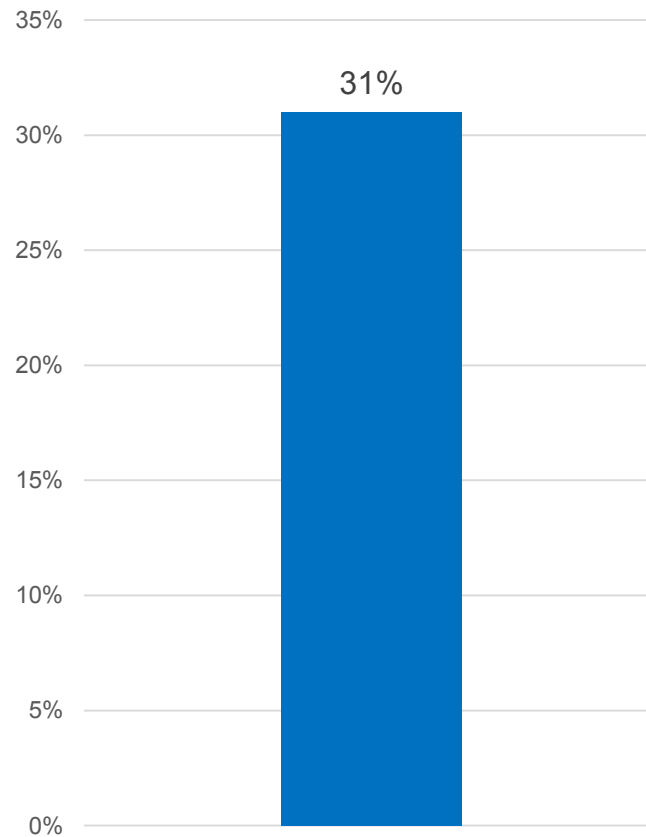


Algebra Nation Impact on EOC Test Scores

- **Fully Developed Online Learning System**
 - Built and tested custom-developed learning management system
 - Made significant improvements to technology, supports, and resources to best meet needs of early childhood teachers
- **Launched Pilot of Early Learning Florida**
 - Field testing in 5 communities
 - Evaluated impact of three models (online only, facilitated community of practice, and with technical assistance coaches)
 - Trained 234 Community of Practice Facilitators
 - Trained 243 Technical Assistance Coaches
 - Obtained \$3,000,000 in philanthropic funding for course and platform development

2015-2016: Full Statewide Implementation

- **All communities statewide**

- **Launch comprehensive evaluation** of Early Learning Florida's impact

2015-2016: Evaluation Study

Yale University and University of Florida evaluation team will measure Early Learning Florida's impact on:

- Improvements in program quality
- Improvements teacher knowledge
- Improvements in teacher skills
- Developmental growth of children
