 2           An act relating to licensure of residential treatment  
 3           facilities; amending s. 394.875, F.S.; providing  
 4           ownership and staffing requirements; providing an  
 5           effective date.

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 7   Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

8           Section 1. Subsections (8), (9), and (10) of section  
 9   394.875, Florida Statutes, are renumbered as subsections (9),  
 10   (10), and (11), respectively, and subsection (8) is added to  
 11   that section, to read:

12           394.875 Crisis stabilization units, residential treatment  
 13   facilities, and residential treatment centers for children and  
 14   adolescents; authorized services; license required.—

15           (8) Nothing in this section shall be interpreted to  
 16   restrict ownership, management, or administration of a  
 17   residential treatment center to a physician licensed pursuant to  
 18   ch. 458 or ch. 459. A facility medical director may be on staff  
 19   or contracted, but must be on call 24 hours a day, 7 days a  
 20   week.

21           Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016.
