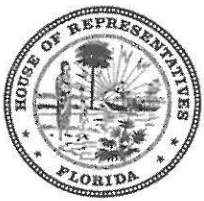

101 with the Division of State Lands of the Department of
102 Environmental Protection and the Jackson County Administrator,
103 shall designate an appropriate public area for the Arthur G.
104 Dozier School for Boys Memorial in Jackson County, Florida. The
105 department shall coordinate with the Division of Historical
106 Resources of the Department of State regarding the design and
107 placement of the memorial, and consider recommendations of
