under the age of 18, a person who has an intellectual disability, or a sexual offense victim or witness, including the use of a service animal, or therapy animal, or facility dog that has been evaluated and registered according to national standards, in any proceeding involving a sexual offense or child abuse, abandonment, or neglect.

- (a) When deciding whether to permit a <u>victim or witness</u> under the age of 18, a person who has an intellectual disability, or a sexual offense victim or witness child victim or witness or sexual offense victim or witness to testify with the assistance of a registered service animal, or therapy animal, or facility dog, the court shall consider the age of the child victim or witness, the age of the sexual offense victim or witness at the time the sexual offense occurred, the interests of the child victim or witness or sexual offense victim or witness, the rights of the parties to the litigation, and any other relevant factor that would facilitate the testimony by the victim or witness under the age of 18, a person who has an intellectual disability, or a sexual offense victim or witness child victim or witness or sexual offense victim or witness.
 - (b) For purposes of this subsection the term:
- 1. "Service animal" means an animal as defined in s. 413.08.
- 2. "Therapy animal" means an animal that is not considered a service animal but has been trained and passed a nationally

3. "Facility dog" means a dog that has been trained, evaluated, and certified as a facility dog pursuant to industry standards and provides unobtrusive emotional support to children and adults in facility settings.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017.

TITLE AMENDMENT

Remove everything before the enacting clause and insert:
An act relating to proceedings involving minors or persons with intellectual disabilities; amending s. 92.55, F.S.; providing that judges may allow the use of certain service animals, therapy animals, or facility dogs in proceedings involving abuse abandonment, or neglect; allowing such animals to be used when taking the testimony of a person who has an intellectual disability; providing an effective date.
